Interact / non-linear / narrative

Objectives:

- To properly structure an XHTML document
- To apply styles to a document via an external style sheet (.css)
- To practice linking within folders
- To further explore the practices of text formatting
- To explore the conceptual possibilities of non-linear narratives

Final Product:

In a folder called Assignment_2:

- 15 short XHTML pages, linked to each other according to the navigational flow of a non-linear fictional narrative.
- One external style sheet, my_styles.css

Details:

Your pages should be properly formatted HTML documents.

Each page should be linked to at least two other pages, giving the user power over the outcome of the story.

Each page should be linked to the same style sheet, and make use of the same text styles.

Concept:

Your pages should follow the structure of a fictional non-linear narrative. You must present multiple storyline options for the user to choose from. When the user clicks an option, they will be taken to a new page in which the narrative will carry on according to the path they have chosen.

The structure of your narrative could be arranged like this:
